- We have a competent team of professionals working with us to arrange your absentee purchases if you are more comfortable attending the sale from your home, your truck in the parking lot or out and about, in your cattle pens and fields. PROXY BIDS or ON THE PHONE bids, can be arranged with any of the persons listed or through our family members listed to right.
- The sale will again be BROADCAST LIVE and offer ONLINE BIDDING through [www.DLMS.ca](http://www.DLMS.ca) Please ***sign up and pre-register early for bidding*** by visiting their website. DLMS suggests that producers in rural areas should also limit the number of

home devices connecting to the Internet, to avoid overwhelming the connection during the sale.

As we make every effort to comply with COVID-19 Guidelines, our family and Cowtown Livestock owners and staff, sincerely appreciate everyone's support as the limitations for ringside attendance are met on sale day.

\* Under these circumstances we are requesting that those who are not prospective buyers or who are not directly involved in the sale to please avoid the seating and interior areas of the building. Also, if you are feeling unwell, please stay home.

\* If you would like to attend on sale day, we ask that only one member of your operation attend the sale.

\* We also recommend following appropriate social distancing and to please wash your hands several times at the provided hand washing stations while on site.

\* Unfortunately a noon lunch will not be provided as the kitchen facility is closed due to the current regulations.

While we all will miss the fellowship of traditional bull sales, we fully intend to make it up to you this summer by treating you, our friends and customers to the camaraderie of our industry with food, hospitality and herd tours at our Customer Appreciation Day.
